Minutes of the Planning Advisory and Highways Committee held on Tuesday 6th June 2023 in the Skyrm Room, Public Hall.

Mrs Smith enquired on progress with regard to the 20mph application and drew members attention to the recent publicity from Fontwell Magna whose application had been refused, in response Cllr Monks advised a draft application would be available for the next meeting of this committee.

1968 Members present: Cllr Beswarick, Cllr Body, Cllr Corbett, Cllr Dawkins, Cllr Gunning, Cllr Monks and Cllr Woods; also Christine Bright (Town Clerk) and one member of the public.

1969 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Biggs, Cllr Goode and Cllr Turner.

1970 ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN

Cllr Dawkins advised that prior to his vacation Cllr Turner had indicated he would be happy to be reelected and in his absence proposed Cllr Turner, seconded by Cllr Monks, there being no other nominations Cllr Turner was duly elected Chairman for ensuing Council year subject to his acceptance. Cllr Monks remained in the chair for the duration of the meeting.

1971 ELECTION OF VICE CHAIRMAN

Cllr Body proposed Cllr Monks, seconded by Cllr Dawkins, there being no other nominations Cllr Monks was duly elected Vice Chairman for the ensuing Council year.

1974 PLANNING ISSUES

(a) To CONSIDER the following PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

1. P/FUL/2022/07766

SITE ADJACENT 82 EAST STREET

Erection of 2 no. dwellings (amended scheme in relation to plots 4 & 5 approved under WD/D./20/00583 (App/D1265/W/21/3267101)

Members considered the amended plans and noted the proposal remained for two much larger dwellings on an already cramped site therefore the committee re-iterated their recommendation to refuse the application on the following grounds:

- The plans did not accurately indicate site levels making it difficult to ascertain exact finished floor levels.
- The significant increase in the size of the properties would have a detrimental effect on the amenity of properties in East Street contrary to Policy ENV16 with regard to overshadowing, overbearing impact and lack of privacy (overlooking)
- The two semi detached properties previously granted had been replaced with two large detached houses contrary to Policy ENV12 the design should be in harmony with adjoining buildings and the area as a whole
- the proposed detached properties were disproportionate to the rest of the development.

Other observations: The introduction of hard surfaces on a previous green field site would exacerbate surface water run-off into East Street properties and the close proximity to the boundary wall would remove the green corridor
