



CB3 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

Minutes of the CB3 Management Committee meeting held in the Cowie Room, Public Hall on Monday 15th June 2026 commencing at 2.15pm.

199 PRESENT: Cllr Dawkins (Chair), Cllr Wallbridge (Vice Chair), Cllr Gunning, Mr Collins, Mr Roberts and Ethan Kalemjian (Administrator).

200 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Gillings and Mr Snow.

201 MINUTES OF THE CB3 MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 11th May 2026

It was **PROPOSED** by Cllr Gunning and **SECONDED** by Cllr Wallbridge and **AGREED** that the Minutes be **APPROVED** and **SIGNED**.

202 MAINTENANCE ISSUES

Mr Collins reported that the bus passed its recent servicing. The Chairman confirmed that the fire extinguishers were serviced.

203 MOSTERTON SHUTTLE SERVICE

The proposed shuttle service for Mosterton's ***Bands on the Green*** event (Sunday 27th July 2026) was considered by the committee, and Mr Roberts highlighted the lack of wider interest that might increase the overall sense of organising the service. The geographic spread of Mosterton could complicate the logistical requirements. Mr Roberts highlighted the relatively high number of Beaminster residents who would likely elect to drive personal vehicles. The Chairman suggested confirming the availability of a driver for Sunday 27th July. (Mr Kalemjian to enquire and report.)

Mr Collins agreed to investigate the details of where the Mosterton car park is situated, and to note any practical requirements. It was **AGREED** that it would be most sensible to keep the arrangements as a private hire. **NOTED**.

204 ROUTE AND FUNDING REVIEW

Mr Roberts explained that the proposed route was largely intended to improve the positioning of the CB3 in relation to the local CR6 bus service. The committee expressed general agreement that by adopting a new route the CB3 would be subject to traffic and

other factors that might complicate the delivery of the service if not adequately considered. Following a lively discussion, the committee **NOTED** the need to improve revenue necessitates consideration of new routes that would improve accessibility to local residents and visitors. Cllr Gunning proposed that Committee members use the CB3 to survey potential routes in order to confirm route viability and report.
